The Perley Rideau Veterans' Health Centre continues to take every precaution to protect the health of residents, staff and essential volunteers during the COVID-19 pandemic. We are collaborating closely with suppliers, stakeholders and partners, including the Government of Ontario, area hospitals and the Chief Public Health Officer of Canada.

At Perley Rideau's recently established Command Centre, senior leaders meet daily to review developments, and to identify and implement appropriate actions, planning for the days and weeks ahead. These meetings will continue for the foreseeable future. Other current measures include visiting and volunteer access restrictions and planning to assign staff to meet resident needs during these extraordinary times. Large gatherings within the Health Centre are prohibited, although the Therapeutic Recreation and Creative Arts team continues to deliver engaging programming to small groups as part of our comprehensive care plan. We are making every effort to continue the Perley Rideau life as usual.

We encourage all members of the Perley Rideau community – residents, family members, staff and volunteers – to support one another during this challenging time. Families are asked to care from a distance. I encourage families and friends not to make unplanned window visits. We want to respect social distancing – even among visitors on our property – and to protect resident privacy.
